#### Yalta ★★ ★

50 Drazhinsky St.

Huge Soviet-era hotel complex, 2km from the town centre. Sweeping views of the Black Sea and private beach. Rooms are basic with balcony, Sat-TV, fridge. Renovated rooms have A/C. 18 restaurants & bars, casino, bowling alley, business centre. A blast from the past.



#### Bristol ★★ ★

10 Roosevelt St.

Boutique hotel built in the 1860s, located in the historical centre, close to the sea front and Massandra Beach. It has been completely renovated with a small restaurant and lobby bar. Comfortable rooms with A/C, Sat-TV, minibar & internet.



#### Oreanda ★★ ★ ★

35/2 Lenin St.

Yalta's most famous hotel, located right on the promenade. Built in 1907 and recently renovated. 114 guest rooms featuring mountain and sea views, A/C, Sat-TV, safe, mini-bar, internet. Restaurants, casino, night club, swimming pool with water slide, private pebble beach.

### Sightseeing

#### City tour & Livadia Palace (4hrs)

Yalta is a charming town which combines elements of the 19th century French Riviera and Soviet-era seaside resorts. Livadia Palace was the site of the "Big Three Conference" in 1945 held by Winston Churchill, Franklin Roosevelt and Josef Stalin. It was built as a summer residence for Tsar Nicholas II in 1911.

#### Sevastopol, Panorama Museum & Kheroneses (8hrs)

The drive between Yalta and Sevastopol is one of the most scenic in Crimea. The naval port of Sevastopol retains a strong Russian feel, due to its importance during the Crimean War and WWII. The Panorama Museum depicts the 349 day siege of Sevastopol in June 1855. The UNESCO World Heritage site of Kheronesus began as a Greek colony.

#### Bakhchisarai & Assumption Monastery (8hrs)

The former Tatar city of Bakhchisarai was founded in the 15th century on the old trade route from Kheronesus to the north. The Khan's palace was built in 1430. The Assumption Monastery and tiny church were built into the limestone rock of the surrounding hill by monks in the 8th and 9th century and is today a working monastery.
