CASTLES & MEDIEVAL FORTRESSES OF TRANSYLVANIA

3 days / 2 nights

Day 1: Bucharest to Brasov & Sighisoara

Meet your guide at 08.30 this morning at hotel reception and depart for Brasov. Your sightseeing of medieval Brasov includes the famous Black Church, St Nicholas Church and the Museum of the first school in Romania. Continue to Sighisoara. Overnight Sighisoara.

Day 2: Sighisoara

After breakfast take a short drive to Biertan to visit the 16th century Saxon fortified church. Return to Sighisoara, the best preserved medieval citadel in Europe. See the clock tower, ancient city walls and Old Town, including the house where

Vlad Dracul (Dracula's father) was born. Overnight Sighisoara. **B**

Day 3: Sighisoara to Sinaia & Bucharest

After breakfast drive south to Bran and visit Bran Castle, built in 1378 as a toll station. Its fairytale appearance has resulted in its nickname of "Dracula's Castle". Continue on to the mountain resort of Sinaia and visit Peles castle, built as the summer residence for King Carol I. Evening arrival Bucharest, where tour services end. **B**

Day 1: Bucharest

Arrive Bucharest. You will be met and transferred to your hotel. Overnight Bucharest.

Morning sightseeing of Bucharest. Highlights include Manuc's Inn, the fascinating Palace of the Parliament and a visit to the Village Museum. Afternoon arrival Brasov. Your sightseeing of medieval Brasov includes the famous Black Church, St Nicholas Church and the Museum of the first school in Romania. Continue to Sighisoara. Overnight Sighisoara. **B**

Day 3: Sibiu & Sighisoara

After breakfast drive to 15th century Sibiu, once an important stronghold for Saxon merchants. After your sightseeing, visit the 16th century Saxon fortified church in Biertan and return to the medieval citadel of Sighisoara, birthplace of Vlad Dracul. See

the clock tower, ancient city walls and Old Town. Overnight Sighisoara. **B**

Day 4: Sighisoara to Bran, Sinaia & Bucharest

This morning drive south to Bran and visit Bran Castle, built in 1378 as a toll station situated on a cliff, dominating the surrounding countryside. Its fairytale appearance has resulted in its nickname of "Dracula's Castle". Continue on to the mountain resort of Sinaia and visit Peles castle, built as the summer residence for King Carol I. Evening arrival Bucharest. Overnight Bucharest. **B**

Day 5: Bucharest

Tour services end after breakfast with your transfer to the airport. **B**
